2. Costs

- expect c. CHF 650.-, not including food, daily expenses, etc.
- could end up being as little as CHF 420.-, not including food, daily expenses, etc.

3. Conditions

- By signing up for the excursion to Dublin, you (a) agree to participate in the group events outlined in the program above, and (b) also sign up for the Bachelor Seminar “Dublin – Trieste – Zurich: The Early Joyce.”
- Only students who have successfully completed “English Literature: Textual Analysis” and “Language Skills and Culture: Introduction” can sign up for the excursion.
- If you sign up for the excursion but then decide not to/are unable to join the trip to Dublin, you still have to pay for the excursion – unless you find another seminar participant who is willing to take over your slot.
- Please note that you will not be allowed to participate in the excursion if you are not booked into the Bachelor Seminar “Dublin – Trieste – Zurich: The Early Joyce” at the time when the excursion takes place (i.e. in early April). In other words, if you sign up for the excursion but then cancel the module “Dublin – Trieste – Zurich: The Early Joyce,” you will no longer be allowed to join the trip. However, you will still have to pay for the slot you have booked, unless you find another seminar participant who is willing to take over your slot.
- We need at least 12 participants for the excursion to take place. The maximum number of participants is 15. If fewer than 12 students sign up, the excursion will have to be cancelled. The slots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- As adults, all participants are responsible for their own safety.
- Note: It is possible to book the module “Dublin – Trieste – Zurich: The Early Joyce” without joining the trip to Dublin. In other words, the excursion is not mandatory for participants of the Bachelor Seminar.
