### Student Assistantship at Chair for Early Modern Literatures in English (10%)

The Chair for Early Modern Literatures in English (Prof. Dr. Isabel Karremann) invites applications for a student assistant to start on

1 August 2026. This student assistant position is initially limited to one semester, with the possibility of extension until the MA-degree has been completed. The position is open only to students enrolled at the English Department.

#### Your responsibilities

Our student assistant will support Prof. Karremann in research and teaching related tasks. Through this, you will get in touch with current publication projects, be involved in conference organization, learn about the planning of seminar programmes, and be involved in the team meetings. This will give you deeper insights into current work done in early modern studies and give you the opportunity to work on your MA-thesis on a related topic.

#### Your profile

Candidates should be proficient in both English and German and have an excellent grades in the field of English literature. You should take a strong interest in the literature and culture from the Renaissance to around 1800, evidenced by successful attendance of lectures or seminars. You have basic skills in office programs (word, power-point) and Adobe Reader.

#### What we offer

We offer a student assistantship position with a workload of 10% in a collegial, supportive and stimulating work environment. The position is initially limited to a one-semester period, with possible extensions per semester until the MA-degree has been completed.
